Police have received a report of scammers contacting people pretending to be from energy companies to discuss the cost of living fuel payment. There is no need to apply for these payments. These callers are not genuine and are trying to obtain personal and banking information. Do not disclose personal or bank account information to these callers and end the call. If you wish to speak to your energy provider, use a number that is known to you. You can usually find a correct telephone number on an energy bill.
